Technology Safety Policy at STEAM Center
Policy 1-2024

GENERAL POLICY:

At our STEAM Center, we recognize the importance of technology in our programs and activities. To ensure the safe and responsible use of technology by participants, we have established a Technology Safety Policy. This policy outlines guidelines and expectations regarding the use of digital devices, online resources, and internet connectivity. Please review and discuss these guidelines with your child before their participation at our center.

Responsible Use of Devices:

Participants are expected to use digital devices provided by the center responsibly and for educational purposes only. This includes following instructions from staff members, using the devices as intended, and refraining from accessing inappropriate content or engaging in unauthorized activities.

Internet Safety:

Participants will be instructed on safe internet practices and the responsible use of online resources. Personal Device Use:

If participants bring personal devices to the STEAM Center, they are responsible for their safekeeping. Staff members will not be held liable for any loss, theft, or damage to personal devices brought to the center.
