8th Annual Mesa Metro Military Classic

Presented by Mesa Metropolitan USBC Association

Purpose – Provide a venue to honor military service and first responders while allowing competition for title and prize money.

Eligibility – Open to all current USBC certified members. If not already a 2026/2027 certified member, membership may be purchased on site. Failure to do so prior to the first ball of competition will result in disqualification of individual scores.

Teams – must include at least 2 players with a military/first responder background and a maximum of 2 guests bowling 3 games each.

Doubles/Singles - each pair includes at least 1 player with a military/first responder background bowling 6 games each. Must bowl both Doubles and Singles events.

All-Events - Optional individual Handicap and/or Scratch for an additional \$10 entry fee each. Fees must be paid prior to bowling any event.

Military/First Responder ID Requirements – Players who are bowling as a military/first responder background player must present proof of service. (Active-Duty Military ID, VA ID, Veterans ID, Veterans designation on driver's license, DD214, etc.)

Handicap – Handicap based on 90% of 230 (230 and higher bowl scratch, no negative handicap). Players without a certified average must bowl scratch. Players use their handicap for each event. Teammates add their handicaps together for a team handicap. Doubles add individual handicaps together for doubles handicap.

Averages – Entrants shall use their 2025-2026 Standard Composite average with 21 minimum games. If no 2025-2026 standard composite average is available, the bowler will use their 2024-2025 standard composite average with 21 minimum games. If no 2024-2025 standard composite, bowlers will use their current league average with 21 games minimum. If neither of the above, the bowler will be assigned an average of 230.

USBC rule 201c, sport rule WILL APPLY.

Deadline – is September 21, 2026. Entries will be accepted after the deadline as space permits, cash only.

Playing Rules – Rules of the Mesa Metro Military & First Responder Classic stated herein, and those of the USBC will govern all participants. The tournament director(s) will have the right to resolve all questions and disputes. All decisions shall be final and binding.

General – Entrants can bowl on multiple teams with at least 2 roster changes. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to find substitutes if needed. **Substitutes** must be submitted to the tournament director at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Optional all-events fees may be transferred to a substitute only if the substitute replaces the original entrant in all entered events prior to participation in any event by either participant. In case of disability after a game has started in the team and doubles events, a substitute will be allowed if one is available and meets criteria required for position on team/doubles (i.e., military/first responder status or guest). Tournament director(s) must approve of any roster changes.

Dress Code – Attire must be neat, clean, and properly fitting. You may only wear: Slacks, Jeans, or dress shorts. Women may wear skorts/skirts provided they extend beyond their fingers when arms are extended down by their sides. Shirts must be: Collared, Mock or collarless bowling jerseys. No hats, caps, clothing with obscenities, holes, frays or tears. No electronics. Tournament director(s) or designee's decision as to the appropriateness of attire will be final.

Payout- Cash prizes in each event shall be on a handicap and scratch basis, with the last paying place at least the amount of the entry for that event. Prize fees will be returned 100%. Pay ratio for this tournament is at least 1 in 6 for Team, Doubles, & Singles. All Events ratios is at least 1 in 10.

Returned checks – Any check in payment of entry fees for the tournament returned for non-payment will be assessed a service charge of \$40.00. Payment must be cleared prior to bowling. We will not accept another check as payment replacement for a returned check.

Tournament Directors' decisions are final.

NO REFUNDS once competition has begun.

The current USBC Book of Rules shall govern any rule not covered above.
