Event Details


The CACW 50 will follow a schedule resembling this. The event will open to vendors and sponsors to setup at 8 am on June 24th, 2023. The 60 individuals registered for the go-kart tournament will arrive for registration, as well as driver and track meetings at 9 am. Racers must be 18 years of age or older and sign a waiver from the Autobahn Country Club. First qualifying heats will begin at 10 am with 3 10-minute sessions. The fastest 10 drivers are split into their heat races. The first of 3 heat races will star at 12:30 pm with the last one concluding at 1:30 pm, each of them will last 12 laps. Drivers who place 7th or better will advance to the main event race. The main event race will start at 2:30pm and will be 20 laps. The winner will be presented a trophy by the Cayuga Centers. The "fastest" qualifying driver award will be presented by AMS Performance. The "clean" racing award will be presented to


the driver who demonstrated the best sportsmanship. The "Hungry" driver award will be presented by Michael Jordan's Steakhouse to the driver who passed the most cars.

The actual exotic car show will open for VIP participants at 10 am with the remaining general audience arriving at 11 am. Each show participant will park in their cars designated park area. Non show attendees will us the holdover lot for parking located the back of the complex. Each designated parking area is for JDM, Exotic, American Muscle and Euro cars exclusively. There will be awards presented by each of the vendors for the best car in each category.

The event itself is expected to draw 1000-1500 spectators. We are planning for 60 racers, and 150-250 car show attendees. Tickets for the vent are priced at \$10 for car show attendees and entrants. If you are 18 years and older and pay the \$100 fee with an accompany waiver, you will be added to the racing roster.
