

This joint effort by Haas CNC and the Haas F1 team will present a unique traveling display for two middle schools, a high school, as well as a university. The interactive display will show

students nationwide the equipment as well as technology that aides the team across its 2022 race campaign. Accordingly, the same machining tools created to build the cars racing will also be highlighted. Each stop will have these displays specific for academic level. They will also be accompanied by a seminar with a question-and-answer spot by Team Principal Gunther Steiner, Haas Owner Gene Haas, and F1 Drivers Kevin Magnussen and Mick Schumacher.

## List of Specific Locations for the tour included with day activities:

- The first stop will take place in Albany, Georgia at Webb Ridge Middle School on May 23rd. The lesson plan for the day will consist of Haas drivers explaining what they do and what a F1 car exactly is. There will be time for students to spend on the simulator equipment that the team has brought along. Gene Haas will also allow students to see a F1 component manufactured in real time.
- The second stop will see the team greet kids at the Circuit of America on May 24th.
   Students from West Ridge Middle School in Austin, Texas will participate in driver meet and greets. The highlight is a real time pit-stop on pit road.
- As the tour winds down, Haas will see students at the Advanced Technologies Academy
  in Las Vegas on May 25th. The team will meet with graduating engineering majored
  seniors to show just what Haas CNC does to aid its Formula 1 team. Gene Haas will take
  center stage as he explains his history as well as his company.
- The final stop is a combined effort from not only the Haas CNC group but the Haas F1 team itself on May 26th. Engineering majoring students will have a chance to play race engineer and driver as they try and fix the car while under race conditions. Additionally, students will utilize basic formulas to create key chains with help of Haas CNC Tools.
