Realising a vision

The vision for Sport Academies Ltd 9 years ago was to provide communities with a free football academy titled: E20 Football Foundation. That idea has developed organically over the years by expanding our projects to all age groups, more sports and now more communities. Along the way we have expanded our business into Community programmes, Events, Education and a Charter Standard Football Club, created jobs and education for London and as part of the Olympic legacy.

Five years after opening our doors, we created and trademarked 'Football Unites' which has become a catalyst for growth and an innovation and is becoming the fastest growing element of our business. We can proudly say we have achieved everything we said we would and more. Today we have over 4,500 people registered on our databases as members – whilst we have recruited over 50 staff throughout the process.

Each year we have felt increased pride in our accomplishments, leading to the launch of our first-ever Impact Report last year – celebrating the work done with our members, stakeholders and community. With even greater success this year (achieving the FA Grassroot Project of the Year), we are delighted to bring you our evaluation report, a showcase of the tangible impact we continue to have locally and regionally even through these difficult times

COMMUNITY

Our community programmes run 6 days a week, 50 weeks of the year and welcome all age groups. For the last 9 years we have been able to run a free football academy exclusive to E20 residents (London's new postcode).

In 2022 we have expanded 'Football Unites' in the community across London.

EDUCATION

In 2022 we expanded our staff team with and additional x3 Full-time staff. Along with 50+ part time staff across our organisation.

Our ambassador programme in collaboration with the Jack Petchey Foundation enables 12-16 year olds to be mentored by our coaches and develop skills to become future coaches.

CLUB

With a database of over 4500 members we were receiving huge demand to enter teams into a league. In the summer of 2022 we expanded our club age groups in Football Unites FC for u8's, u9's, u10's, u11's, u13's, u16's, u18's and Men's for the London

EVENTS

This year we have expanded our events services by running the E20 Adult Cup, The E20 Commercial Cup and multiple children mini World Cup competitions.

Our events do not stop there, we deliver on holidays camps, after-school activities and most recently; a Family Summer Programme delivering a variety of sports.

57% = Male Participants




293,922 participation numbers since its opening
