Payout Volunteer Procedure

- After putting is complete the daily payout volunteers will ensure the scorecards are placed in one
 of three bins:
 - Hole-in-one (HIO) scorecard will be placed in a RED bin marked hole-in-one cards (only
 one of the putter's scorecards will be placed in this bin).
 - The daily payout volunteer will circle the HIO/Magic Hole in a RED pencil, document the number of HIO's at the top of the card and circle that number in RED pencil.
 - The second HIO scorecard will be placed in a **BLUE** bin marked **2**nd **hole-in-one cards**.
 - Cards without HIO will be placed in a GREEN bin marked no hole-in-one cards.

- Daily payout volunteers will document the HIO on the payout sheets provided by the daily codirector.
- Take the scorecards from the HIO **RED** bin and give them to the bird awards volunteer.
- All other cards from the **BLUE** and **GREEN** bins will go to the awards money volunteers.
- Complete the electronic data entry no later than 24 hours after putting.
- Members who are volunteers for payout may "play through" so they can complete their play and be ready when putting is concluded.
