NEW BUSINESS REPORT:

CHAIR REPORT:

- 1. Kathy Kerney reported on the Annual Brunch that will be held on February 29, 2024. The theme is Leap into Spring. Each day will create two baskets with a cost between \$50.00 \$75.00.
