

LADY PUTTERS (LP) HISTORY

1998 – LP began in 1998 with seven (7) ladies and one putting session each week at Granite Falls putting green. The idea for this activity was introduced by a resident who had lived in a Del Webb community in Palm Springs. Membership in this activity quickly increased and it was eligible to apply to become a Charter Club. A club needed 100 members to apply for Charter status.

1999 – LP was authorized as a Charter Club on May 2, 1999

2002 – LP was now putting at Granite Falls putting green and Desert Springs putting green. The club putted on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

2003 – LP was moved to the new Cimarron putting green. Thursday and Friday were added to the daily putting schedules. Membership was 700+ ladies.

2013 – LP joined the Men's putting club and the Couples putting club to form the Grand Putter's group. This was an "umbrella" group whose purpose was to pursue the construction of a storage building and restrooms at the Cimarron putting green.

2014 – The storage building and rest rooms were approved, and the construction completed in September 2014. The facility accommodates the three (3) putting clubs in Sun City Grand.

2017 – The extension of the Ramada area and the steps and railings leading to the putting green were completed.
