

LADY PUTTERS (LP) STANDING RULES - MEMBERS

1. New member dues are sixty-five dollars (\$65) for the first year of membership. This includes 1-year membership, a new LP shirt, apron, and a name tag. Membership will begin the following week after receipt of your check and completed application by the treasurer and the membership chair. New members will pay the putting fee of two (\$2) dollars for each week of play using their credit book. You are required to complete five (5) putting sessions with valid scorecards to establish a handicap, and before being eligible for low gross (LG) or low net (LN) money prizes. Disqualified cards (DQ) do not count as a valid scorecard. Putting is allowed only one day per week per member.
2. Annual dues are payable by May 31st, to ensure carryover of hole-in-one (HIO) and handicaps into the next putting season. Annual renewal dues are twenty dollars (\$20) for the putting season of November thru May. If a member requests their dues refunded prior to the beginning of the putting season it will be refunded.
3. Former members may join at the annual renewal price of twenty dollars (\$20) if the putter last played within the past five seasons
4. Cell phones as a courtesy should be on vibrate or turned off during the putting sessions.
5. Resident guests may putt free three (3) times before joining the Lady Putters club. Resident guests are not eligible for any money awards. Non-resident guests of members who are staying with the resident, may putt free three (3) times per putting season. Non-residents of Sun City Grand may not putt. There are no fees for guests. Guests are not eligible for any money awards.
6. Volunteers are critical to the success of LP. Members are encouraged to volunteer to assist in the operation of the club. Service can be rendered in the form of serving as an elected officer, committee chair, committee member or daily volunteer. Please view the LP website for volunteer job opportunities.
7. Selling of personal merchandise purchased or handmade may not be sold during the daily putting sessions, luncheons, or at special events.
8. Establish your credit book at any Pro Shop by adding a minimum of \$20 before our putting season begins.
 - a. Two dollars (\$2) are for the LP prize fund/credit book
9. November thru April check-in time is 9:00-9:30 am with play beginning after announcements. For the month of May check-in time is 7:30-8:00 am with play beginning after announcements.

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10. The Lady Putters uniform must be worn at each putting session. New members are required to purchase a shirt, apron, and name tag from the Club. The official LP attire is a Lady Putters monogrammed sleeved shirt and either white or black shorts, slacks, skort, capris pants, or skirt. Leggings are allowed but must be below the knee in length. Women's workout attire is prohibited. SCG golf rules prohibit long or short sleeved tee-shirts, tank top of any style, halter-tops, cut-offs, denim of any color, tracksuits, swimwear, and any clothing with tears or holes. Athletic leisure wear is also allowed if it meets the criteria above. All clothing should be neat and clean. Shoes, no neon or bright colors, flip flops, or non-approved golf sandals. Golf shoes with cleats are not allowed. During the month of May, a shirt of your choice may be worn. This shirt can be sleeveless with a collar or collarless with sleeves.
11. When a member has accumulated five (5) HIOs, throughout the putting season, she qualifies for a small bird regardless of when the HIOs occur (e.g., three (3) in one session, five (5) over multiple sessions)
12. When a member gets three (3) HIOs during one putting session, she qualifies for a big bird and the three (3) HIOs count towards a small bird.
13. Money awards are calculated each week for the LG and LN score in each handicap flight. Magic Hole (MH) money awards are recorded for each month. LG, LN, HIO, and MH awards are posted on the members credit book according to an established yearly schedule. Only completed and correct scorecards are eligible for LG, LN, and MH money awards.
14. Payment for club events is by check only unless stated by the LP Boad of Directors. No refunds will be issued after a stated deadline. The selling of purchased tickets must be arranged by the individual putter and not the luncheon committee or the daily directors.
15. LP will not provide, be responsible for or pay for personal equipment that is being used by members of any entertainment group that performs at any of our functions. Guests may be invited to attend our events only after current members have purchased tickets and guests must pay the entire cost of the meal.
16. In the event of a frost delay at Cimarron that is 9:30 am or earlier we will putt that session. In the event of a frost delay at Cimarron that is after 9:30 am we will not putt that session. You will be notified via email by your daily directors.
