

## Welcome to Sun City Grand Lady Putters

**DAILY COST:** Two (\$2) each week will be paid to Lady Putters from your credit book. Money should be added to your credit book at any Pro Shop before you begin putting for the first time

**ATTIRE:** The Lady Putters official attire must be worn at the putting sessions. Membership includes a shirt, apron, name tag, and dues.

The official Lady Putters attire is the Lady Putters monogrammed sleeved blue shirt and either black or white golf shorts, slacks, skort, capris, pants, or skirt. Leggings are allowed but must be below the knee in length. Women's workout attire is prohibited. SCG golf rules prohibit long or short sleeved tee-shirts, tank top of any style, halter-tops, cut-offs, denim of any color, tracksuits, swimwear, and any clothing with tears or holes. Athletic leisure wear is also allowed if it meets the criteria above. All clothing should be neat and clean. Shoes should be comfortable, not neon or bright colors, flip flops, or non-approved golf sandals. Golf shoes with cleats are not allowed.

During the month of May, a shirt of your choice (preferably blue) may be worn. This shirt may be either sleeveless with a collar or collarless with sleeves. SCG golf rules prohibit the wearing of a tank top.

**CHECK-IN:** November thru April is 9:00 a.m. to 9:25 am  
May is 7:30 a.m. to 7:55 am

**HANDICAP:** You will receive a handicap after you have putted successfully five (5) times meaning no disqualifications. Until you receive a handicap, use an "X" on your scorecard under HDCP. You will **not** be eligible for either Low Gross (LG) or Low Net (LN) awards until you establish a handicap.

### Putting Rules Used by Lady Putters

Here are a few putting rules to know before you putt.

1. No practice putting is allowed on the putting green the day of play
2. Start all putts as indicated by the white arrows. Place the ball on the left side of the arrow if you putt right-handed or place the ball on the right side of the arrow if you putt left-handed. If you cannot place your own ball, please ask your partner to do it for you.

1. At check-in you will be given a scorecard by the scorecard volunteer. The number in the upper right-hand corner is your starting hole.
2. Print or sign your name at the top of the scorecard (**Last name, first name or first name, last name**)
3. Fill in today's date
4. Circle the hole number that you are starting on
5. Print your **first and last name** in the first free space in the column on the under the word "hole"
6. Sign or print your name on the scorecard next to the word "**SCORER**"
7. Check your handicap on the display board. Place your handicap in the **HDCP** column. **If you do not have a handicap, place an "X" in the HDCP column.**
8. Once at your assigned hole, print your partner's name below your name and add her handicap under your handicap in the **HDCP** column. If your partner does not have an **HDCP** place an "X" in the **HDCP** column. If your partner is a guest, place a "**G**" in the **HDCP** column. Leave a space after your name when adding your partner's name.
9. Record scores after each play. Check with your partner before recording all scores on the scorecard.
10. Circle all **holes-in-ones (HIO)** for each player
11. Record total score of first nine holes in the "**OUT**" column
12. Record total score of second nine holes in the "**IN**" column
13. Upon completion of play add the "**OUT**" and "**IN**" totals. Place that number in the "**TOTAL**" column.
14. Subtract your handicap, if you have one, from the number in the "**TOTAL**" column and post it in the "**NET**" column. Do the same procedure for your partner's score.
15. Verbally check your scorecard with your partner's scorecard, making sure they are the same. Be sure your scorecard is signed next to the "**SCORER**" space. **A scorecard will be disqualified if the scores are not correct, or complete. The card that is disqualified will not be eligible for Low Gross (LG), Low Net (LN), or Magic Hole (MH) awards, but will still receive hole-in-one (HIO).**
16. All scorecards must be turned into the Payout table
