About Concrete

Concrete is long established as a versatile hard wearing and economical material for use in building and hard landscaping. It can be cast in moulds enabling production of a variety of decorative shapes and sizes as well as attractive surface finishes. It's compressive strength is well up to the demands made of it during normal use as a garden landscaping material.


Concrete is not a totally controllable material when it comes to colour, and variations can occur due to a combination of the humidity and temperature during curing and the normal variety of colours in the natural aggregate materials. Samples are displayed and offered on this understanding.

Patchiness can also occur when slabs are packed together, this may result in a dark centre, usually more conspicuous on smooth slabs. This will reduce and often disappear altogether as the slabs are exposed to weather.

After long exposure, paving will usually show signs of weathering and probably will have become dirty from atmospheric dust. Water and a stiff brush will usually be sufficient to remove dirt. Chemicals are available as patio cleaners, but care should be taken since they sometimes etch the wearing surface and the clean effect is short lived. Water pressure sprays should also be used sympathetically. De-icing salts will harm the surface and should not be used.





A Slab Laying Guide





Follow these 6 easy steps


- 1. Using a scaled plan of the patio, mark out its position using pegs and a line, clearing the site of all vegetation.
- 2. Dig out your soil to a depth of about 150mm or 6" below the finished patio level, ensuring the soil is compacted.
- 3. Spread a good layer of at least 100mm or 4" thick of hardcore over the excavated area. Remember to leave room for the thickness of the slabs and around 30-50mm or approximately 2" of mortar. Compact this layer of hardcore thoroughly, ideally using a plate compactor if you have one.
- 4. Using your house wall, fence or pegs and line a reference, start to lay your slabs. Tap each slab down using a rubber mallet and continuously check they are level. You can use wooden spacers to ensure equal gaps between slabs.
- 5. Continue until all the slabs in your patio are laid, being careful to check you follow your slope level as you go. If any of your slabs have to be cut, use an angle grinder to cut your slabs effectively.
- 6. When the patio is finished, wait a few days for the mortar to set. Fill joints with a dry mix mortar— or resin (follow instructions on box)- and once completed wet using a watering can with a fine rose. Alternatively use a recommended chemical mortar. Again leave for a couple of days before enjoying your completed patio.


Remember:

Your patio should be at least 150mm or 6" below your house d.p.c. (Damp proof course) if it's next to the house. Slope the patio away from walls or fence, a slope of 25mm over 1.5m (or 1:60) should be sufficient.

Laying in this pattern will give roughly the same number of each size. To work out number of slabs needed—laid as below:

600x600mm, 600x300, 300x300. Divide by 0.63 for the number of each size of slab. **Alternatively for other areas:** Laid as: 600x600mm– divide by 0.36 or 450x450mm– divide by 0.2025.


SLOTTED POSTS FOR PANEL FENCING


These posts are designed to be used with approximately 2'0 (600 mm) in the ground and the remaining slot in-filled by timber fabricated panels, with or without concrete gravel boards as listed opposite. Longer posts should be used on sloping or unstable terrain.


For a solid concrete fence they can be in-filled with gravel boards or with the more decorative TIMBERLAP or Yorkstone Walling Panels.

IMPORTANT: Concrete panels should not exceed a height of 6'0 (1.83 metres) above ground level, nor be used as retaining walls

Please note: our posts have slightly under 2'0 under the nib (which goes at ground level), and as such are just under the given length.








