Why I Should Be Edmonton's Next Mayor

My plan to review departments' ineffective and wasteful spending will ensure transparency. Every dollar must work for Edmontonians, not special interests.
- Public safety and homelessness are top voter concerns. Open drug use and crime require my zero-tolerance approach and a unified strategy to address root causes. As mayor, I'll rebuild trust between City Council and the Edmonton Police Commission, creating a committee to integrate existing assets—Edmonton Police Service, Transit Peace Officers, Corporate Security, and Alberta Community Peace Officers within current budgets. This smarter approach will make Edmonton a place where families and businesses will build, thrive, and live in safety.
- I'm the only mayoral candidate to promise a motion to repeal the
 disastrous Zoning Bylaw 20001. Its "wild-west" rules, with no clearance
 or parking requirements for large and multiple mid-block structures,
 strip homeowners of recourse against incompatible developments. I'll
 restore sensible zoning by reverting to Bylaw 12800, which supports
 strong infill development while respecting Edmonton's heritage and
 meeting our housing needs.
- Edmonton's economy must diversify to secure our future. By keeping business taxes low, removing red tape and roadblocks, I'll advance the

- Horse Hill Energy Park to attract value-added industries, creating jobs and competing with hubs like Nisku and Acheson.
- I'll also address the Blatchford development. This 13-year vanity project
 has already cost the city hundreds of millions of taxpayers' dollars with
 pitifully low results and expensive homes for sale. With hundreds of
 millions more in spending planned and a newly announced final buildout of 2042, 29 years after the last plane left the city centre airport, this
 is simply unacceptable. I will work with builders to develop a thriving
 new neighbourhood on the Exhibition grounds and other practical
 locations.
- I'll freeze hundreds of millions in bike lane spending, removing those that impede traffic or goods and services by reducing roadways.
- To reduce confusion and help all Edmontonians know which ward they live in, I'll add ward numbers in blackets alongside their names, like Ipiihkoohkanipiaohtsi (10).
- I will motion to repeal Edmonton's single-use plastics bylaw, which costs Edmontonians money and jobs.
- I will reinstate the City's Interfaith Chaplain and Senior Mental Health Consultant position for its over 13,000 employees. The city should have never eliminated this important position.
- I want to reignite Edmonton's spirit through a Mayor's "City of Champions" initiative. This is about honouring our innovators, everyday Edmontonians, and builders who made and make our city exceptional. It will be a Virtual Hall of Fame, to inspire the next generation to be equally great, while not costing taxpayers any money.

On October 20, 2025, Edmontonians will choose a mayor who listens, acts with principle, and delivers fiscally responsible results. My 14 years of experience and clear plan to restore fiscal discipline, enhance safety, protect neighbourhoods, and celebrate our spirit make me the best choice to lead the next four years. I humbly ask for your vote to build a stronger, prouder Edmonton.
