The summer is rapidly approaching and we have been in preparation mode. We are grateful for all of our volunteers who come out on the third Saturday of each month to assist us in the farming efforts and to participate with our young men and help them develop understanding about the farming processes. There are always plenty of projects at Son Farm and we encourage you to bring your family or men’s group and come join us on the third Saturday morning of each month, from 8:00 am – 12:00. The next farm day will be May 15th. Let us know that you are coming, to make sure we have lunch portions for everyone.

We have quite a variety of organic produce for our share partners this season: variety of peppers, tomatoes, potatoes, onions, kale, turnips/green, celery, okra, squash, cucumbers, beets, radishes, berries, melons, celery, garlic and more. All of our produce is grown without pesticides, herbicides and no gmo seeds.

When you purchase a Son Farm share/produce box, you will receive 12-15 pounds of produce, with an additional 5 pounds added during melon season. Your purchase allows us to provide our sons that are 15 and older with meaningful work experiences during the summer months. Oneness: The Culture of a Family
