Oneness

There is no variance in oneness. Yahuah (God the Father) and Yahusha (Jesus the Son) have always been and will always be one.

Phillip, one of the 12 disciples asked Yahusha (Jesus) to show them the Father.

*Jesus said unto him, **Have I been so long with you, and yet have you not known me, Philip? He that has seen me has seen the Father.***

—JOHN 14:9-11

Yahusha (Jesus) says:

Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. For it has been declared unto me of you, my brethern, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. Now this I say, that every one of you say, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ. Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? The answer is no. Yahusha (Jesus) is not divided and there is no variance.— I CORINTHIANS 1:10-13

With darkness filling the earth and troubles economically, politically, socially, culturally and spiritually; oneness to confront the darkness and bring forth Father's light is the Mosthigh's solution. Christ is not divided; but why do we have over 45,000 Christian denominations all proclaiming they are the way?

We can only become one by being totally surrendered to the leading and guidance of the Holy Spirit. We must understand that the issue is the variances in our soul. Yahuah (God the Father) has always been one and will always be one.

There are no personal opinions, divisions, competitions, or democratic processes in spiritual oneness. There is only the theocratic divine governance; where the comforter (the Holy Spirit) leads us in the way, the truth, and the life as stated in John:

*Yahusha (Jesus) said unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by me.*** —JOHN 14:6

This is the way that Yahusha Hamashiach (Jesus Christ) lived his 33 years on earth, always doing the will of his Father God (Yah.)

He was always one with the Father and his Father was one with him on the cross. We know this because his father would never leave him nor forsake him. They were one in soul and spirit. It was God **the judge** that allowed Yahusha's (Jesus's) body to be the atonement for the sins of all of mankind and his soul and spirit remained in oneness with his Father through the brutal crucifixion. (This is why Jesus said "**My God, My God why have you forsaken me.**" —MATTHEW 27:46)

His body was beaten, pierced, beard jerked out, crowned with thorns, and hung naked nailed to calvary's cross: but his soul remained holy and obedient *and his spirit was one with his Father*. The blood of (Yahusha) Jesus that ran from his body continues to wash us from our sins and trespasses today.

When we the body of Hamashiach (Christ) become one, there will be great grace and power upon us all. When our soul submits to the Holy Spirit of Yah (God) that dwells within us, we are then brought into divine alignment and oneness.

And the multitude of them that believed were of one spirit and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common. And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all. Neither* was there any among them that lacked.* —ACTS 4: 32-34

There is another clear example of oneness without the leading of the Spirit in Genesis:

And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and

let us make us a name, otherwise we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. And the Lord said, Behold, the people are one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. —GENESIS 11:4-6

These souls were one and they all spoke the same language but they were out of alignment with the Mosthigh, Our Father. He stepped in and confounded their languages because their oneness would have allowed them to accomplish great things for the cause of evil.

Let's pray and believe the Mosthigh for understanding and ask him to lead us in the path of righteousness and oneness. John 17:21 Jesus prayed, ***That they all may be one; as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that you have sent me.***
