

FATHERING & FATHERHOOD ARE WE READY

When we were directed by our Heavenly Father (the Most High) to birth the Family Foundation Fund in December 1992, the commission was clear to restore the Father's heart to a culture where the father had become increasingly absent. John 17: 1 "These words spoke Jesus and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son Also may glorify you."

Yehuda, the son of God, knew what time it was. Do we know what time it is on the prophetic time clock?

John 17: 4-5 "I have glorified you on the earth: I have finished the work which you gave me to do. And now, O Father, glorify me with thine own self with the glory which I had with you before the world was."

Yehuda, asked his father to be glorified in him. He asked for the same divine glory that they had together before the foundations of the world. In Father's glory is peace, glorious light, abounding joy, and eternal love. Have we asked our Father to be glorified in us?

John 17:6-8 "I have manifested your name into the men which you gave me out of the world: yours they were, and you gave them to me; and they have kept your word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever you have given me are of you. For I have given unto them the words which you gave me; and they have received them."

Yehuda had placed his father's name (Yah) on display with the twelve disciples (spiritual sons) that had been entrusted to him. As fathers we are entrusted with the care of the souls of our wife, children, and the generations that will follow us as we manifest His name.

John 17:10-11 "And all mine are yours, and yours are mine; and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to you, Holy Father keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me that they may be one, as we are."

The spirit of every member of our families was with Our Heavenly Father before they were born into the earth. The Heavenly Father's intent was for fathers on earth to prepare their family's physical, mental/emotional, and spiritual maturity for His glory. Are we being one with our heavenly Father and his *glory being manifest in our families?*

John 17: 14-17 "I have given them your word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world even as I am not of the world. I pray not that you should take them out of the world, but that you should keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."

Parents who are abiding in their sonship have the responsibility to live in a kingdom understanding and reality. Our spirit did not originate in this world. Our body and soul originated through our fathers and mothers. So when we live as sons of the Most High, as Yehuda did, we are not bound by the world's limitations. "We can do all things through Christ who strengthens us. "Philippians 4:13

We generally read and hear the translation of our Savior/Messiah's name... in English Jesus...the original name from the Heavenly Father was Hebrew (Yah-Father) and (Yehuda-Son). In our modern day culture when a son is born and the father & mother name him Thomas, in Spanish his name would be Tomas, as a boy family would call him Tommy, as a man he would be called Tom. He would answer to all of these names... but the parent named him Thomas? When we honor the name The Most High gave his only begotten Son, it makes a tremendous difference!
