

## **Summary of Guidelines for Returning to In-Person Worship during Phase One**

*We are excited about gathering to worship again in our building and are trying to create a safe and caring environment where participant can focus on worship.*

Until Phase One officially ends, we will use the following guidelines:

- Use good judgment about how safe it is for you to attend. Services will be streamed live, online.
- If you are showing any signs of sickness, please stay at home.
- Please do not arrive too early. Allow enough time to get in and be seated before the service starts. There will not be an opportunity to mingle before or after the service.
- Park, enter, and exit only on the west side of the building. Enter through the glass doors (back of the sanctuary) and exit through the front (near the piano).
- The golf cart will not be available. Those who are able to walk without difficulty, should voluntarily park farther from the entrance to let those who need to do so park closer.
- Maintain 6 ft distance between family groups (on all sides), entering, exiting, and during the service.
- Seating available in every other row.
- Every time a restroom is used, someone must disinfect all handles that were touched. (Disinfectant will be available in the restroom.)
- Face masks are recommended (especially while entering and leaving and for those in high risk categories), but not required.
- Someone wearing a mask will open doors for entering and exiting.
- We will exit sequentially, by rows, with the rows closest to the exit leaving first.
- There will be no nursery or children's worship, however, families with small children have the option of worshipping from the fellowship hall with the entire family together at a table.
- There will be no other in-person services or programs during the week.
- Offering envelopes and bulletins will be available to pick up after sanitizing your hands.
- If you have envelopes, you may drop your offering in a basket as you enter. If you need to fill out the envelope before giving, there will also be baskets available as you exit.
