Dear Partner in Ministry,

Trusting and praying this letter finds you well & basking in the abundant blessings of our Father.

From this side of the world it seems that one day tumbles over the next and uprights itself just in time to greet the coming day. We have been in accelerated mode for some time and there doesn't seem to be any letting up.

Our major project has been the construction of our new kitchen which is progressing nicely, (I'm still without a system to send pictures electronically) partly due to my age and partly due to the age of my computer. I look forward to the time when I can update you with a pictorial review.

We are eagerly awaiting harvest time for our maize crop which will be in August. From outward appearances, it looks to be a fruitful yield. Beans have been harvested and we are eating from the good of the land. Our sukuma wiki (kale) is also yielding on a daily basis and is one of our staples. We are thankful for the Lord's provision. Shortage of food supply in some areas and inflated prices make it difficult for families to provide for their own needs. We are blessed to have our needs met from what is growing on our land.

With the impending election and Kenya's history of political unrest and insecurity, we are being advised to store up supplies for at least a month to push us through any possible shortages or unpredictable circumstances.

Since the last letter, we have had three children, two brothers, ages eight and ten and their 12 year old sister placed in our home by the Children's Dept. They were rescued from dire circumstances and are just now starting school. Social skills are lacking in several areas and they are hungry for love and attention in which there is plenty to go around. Please pray for Joseph, Muhindi and Damaris as they adjust to their new environment and settle into new routines.

Schools will close for the August holiday on 28th July decreasing the number of vehicles moving around during the up coming election on August 8th. Please keep Kenya in your prayers as many promises of a peaceful election are being made in the midst of turmoil.

We appreciate your continued faithfulness to pray and financially support the work that God is blessing and we always lift you up in prayer and send blessings in abundance.
