Life as we know it is slowly returning to normal. Normal in a third world country takes on a whole different meaning during National elections.

For the most part, peace reigned and polling places were quiet and organized. The results were not known until five days later when the announcement came saying the incumbent had won the elections. Tensions began to mount as the opposition called for people to boycott their work place and also to boycott the daily newspaper.



There were a few potentially volatile "hot spots" and people were told to stay in their homes and compounds. Churches were closed on Sunday. We are thankful that we are located 2-2 1/2 hours in any direction from any of the hot spots.

Store shelves were empty as suppliers could not deliver their goods. We were advised to lay up at least one months supply of commodities, so we are still fine since most of our staples are from our own crops.

All schools are closed for the holiday until 28 August so all of our children are home. Some of our staff members have brought their families to stay during the holiday which gives them the opportunity to enjoy the beautiful change in environment as well as having different play mates until school starts.

We are very grateful for your continued prayer and financial support. We know we are walking in God's favor and we pray God's blessings will be multiplied over all you do.
