Dear Partner in Ministry,

It isn't over 'til' it's over! I left you with the message that the elections took place and the incumbent won the election. However, the opposition challenged the results and took issues to the supreme Court. The decision was to call a new election within sixty days. The new date is set for October 26 for the repeat poll.

There are still a lot of unhappy campers and a new wave of political unrest accompanied by violence in some areas around the country. I am again asking for your continued prayer support for divine protection and provision. While we are experiencing heavy rainfall, other parts of the country are in severe drought, whereby people and animals are dying for lack of food and water.

The opposition has declared every Monday, Wednesday and Friday to be days for public demonstrations. He has also stated that he will not participate in a new poll if his demands are not met. What is intended to be 'peaceful' demonstrations have turned violent and are becoming running gun battles with the police. Some of our staff and their families live in these areas and are having to travel to and from their homes to get to Malava. Please pray for their safety.

In the midst of all the turmoil, students are scheduled to sit for their National Exams for entrance into Secondary School. Two of our students, Winnie Akinyi and Sandra Owuor are scheduled for the exams taking place from October 26 - November 2. Please pray for their success as they close out one phase of their education and embark on another as Secondary School students in January 2018.

In our own schools, Lighthouse pre-school is closing on October 19. We are also in the process of enrolling new pre-school students in our third pre-school class which will begin in January. Malava Christian Academy will close on October 24. The activity ends abruptly followed by two months of catch up time and hopefully some leisure time away for a few days.
