### **-TRACK RULES-**

Our goal is to provide a fun, safe and challenging experience at The Brickyard. A track is nothing without its drivers and vehicles. The rules at The Brickyard are meant to insure fair competition and safety for the drivers, their vehicles, spectators, marshals, the track and facilities. They also ensure a welcoming and friendly experience for our customers and guests.

Some rules being broken will result in immediate disqualification from the race, and ejection from the property for the day; including potential, *permanent*, ban from the track. We understand emotions can run high when racing, especially if another driver is not following the rules. Please stay calm and let us know if there is a problem – we will address it in a calm professional manner. **Drivers and spectators must follow the below regulations:**

#### **Serious Infractions – Zero Tolerance**

- Fighting
- Alcohol (use on-site or arriving intoxicated)
- Drugs/Drug Paraphernalia
- Extreme/Excessive Foul Language
- Intentional destruction of track, rental equipment, other vehicles, facility AND/OR your personal property
- Intentional dangerous or reckless driving
- At our discretion, any behavior or actions that create a negative environment

#### **Personal Conduct**

- One adult per child (13 and under) at ALL times on the property - NO EXCEPTIONS
- No children under 8 allowed on the driver stand – NO EXCEPTIONS
- NO SPECTATORS on the driver stand; drivers ONLY
- Keep your actions and conversations family friendly
- No running, shouting, throwing objects or littering
- Absolutely NO food, drinks, smoking or tobacco spitting while on the driver stand
- DRIVERS – if anyone enters the course other than a marshal or staff, STOP YOUR VEHICLE IMMEDIATELY

#### **Driver Etiquette**

- Leader RIGHT OF WAY, ALWAYS
- No yelling at turn marshals
- Protect the turn marshals
- No excessive/loud talking during the race near the driver stand
- Stand up straight when at the rail. If you are unable, we will do our best to accommodate your requests prior to the start of the race or practice session
- If you crash on your lid, STOP and wait for a marshal
- If your vehicle is crashed, a marshal will only reset if your vehicle is at rest

#### **Cheating**

The Brickyard race classes vary, and rules per class are specific. If a driver is suspicious of another driver cheating, bring it to the staff's attention **immediately**. It is within the staff's rights to choose how to handle the situation with the accused.

***CAREFULLY CONSIDER THE CONCIQUENCES BEFORE CHEATING OR ACCUSING SOMEONE ELSE!!!***

#### Cheating Appeal

If you feel the issue remains unresolved by The Brickyard staff and are committed to further investigation into another driver cheating, there is an appeal process as follows:

Accuser puts up \$50.00 cash. Accused has a choice – refuse the challenge and remove the suspect vehicle(s) from the track and the race. No refunds will be given for entry fees. OR, accept the challenge and allow track officials to inspect the vehicle. If no violations are discovered, accused gets the \$50.00 cash from the accuser. If violations are found, the accuser gets the vehicle in violation and the track gets \$50.00 from the accuser. If tempers flair and either the accused or accuser are unable to handle themselves in a professional and calm manner, the case will be immediately ruled AGAINST the offending party.
