

Are Others Benefiting From Your Spiritual Gifts?

Romans 1:11-12 reads like this: "For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you— that is, that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine."

The translation "impart to you some spiritual gift" is **misleading** because it sounds like Paul wants to help them have a gift, but the text actually means that he wants to **give them** the benefit of his gifts. "I long to see you, that I may use **my gifts to strengthen you.**"

The first and most obvious thing we learn from these verses is that spiritual **gifts are for strengthening others.** Or we could say the gifts are **given to be given.** They aren't given to remain unused. Remember "To **each** is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." 1 Corinthians 12:7

When the apostle Paul used the word "strengthen" in verse 11 he was referring to the word "faith" in vs 12. So we can say that "to strengthen someone by a spiritual gift means to help their faith not fail **as easily** when troubles enter their lives. God gives us spiritual gifts to help others endure during the challenges and storms of life."

Here is my challenge for this week:

We need to approach every day by saying

"Lord Jesus, thank you for saving my soul, **how can I strengthen someone's faith today?** Grant that at the end of this day, *someone* will be more confident of your promises and more encouraged to persevere because I did something rather than nothing.

That was my challenge to our Wednesday night Bible study. The next day as I was on my way to an appointment in Haslet I stopped at a car wash. As I was preparing to vacuum my truck an older man parked next to me, greeted me and in conversation told me that his wife of 55 yrs had just passed away. Thankfully both he and his wife were believers, but he was hurting. All I did was to listen, express my sorrow for his grief and put my arm around him and pray for him.

God hears our prayers! God answers our prayers! God uses the gifts He gives us to strengthen the faith of others...and our faith is strengthened in the process.

My challenge is this....to voice that prayer **each day this week**, then be ready to use your spiritual gift, whatever it is to encourage another's faith...knowing that your faith will be encouraged in the process!
