A God Given Vision

For many years I’ve shared a Biblical vision for Harmony based on Scripture like the Great Commission.

1.) Matthew 28:18-20 The Great Commission. "Make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey all of Christ’s commands".

This is the most important thing Jesus told us that we should do. We do this by sharing the gospel, teaching new believers how to live and supporting missions and ministries at home and around the world. If we fail at this, we fail at the most important command given by the Lord Jesus Christ.

Our biggest effort in terms of time and energy **locally, outside** the church is the after school Bible club, called Kid’s Beach Club. It is 90 minutes of small group time, worship songs, Bible teaching, Scripture memory and games that reinforce the Scripture/Character word of the week. In short, it’s evangelism and discipleship. This is a direct link to our vision from Matt.28 of making disciples.

Currently, 5 of us are responsible for this ministry weekly, that represents 4% of our membership. That means that a major outreach into the community is being accomplished by only 4% of our average attendance.

We participate in other out reaches like VBS which involves more people, but only lasts 4 days a year.

My point here is just to start sharing a Biblical vision for Harmony that every member will know by heart. **We must be a disciple making church.** That is our primary purpose. We can and should do lots of other good things, but if making disciples isn’t our primary focus we have failed at the most important thing the Lord Jesus told us to do. Our vision as a church is "To love our community and the world by making disciples who make disciples." I’ll have more of the vision for Harmony next week, **but let’s ask ourselves what role we are playing in "making disciples of all nations?"** Matt. 28:19-20

The Lord has always been at work at Harmony but He’s "sharpening our focus" in these days!

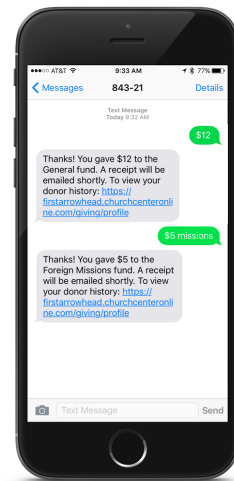
- Prayers for Susan as she recovers from wrist surgery.
