What Made Tyler Strong?

Tyler Trent, a 20 yr old college student from Purdue University died January 1. When Tyler's cancer ended his time as a college student, he predicted that Purdue would win the football game against Ohio State. At that point no one ex-

pected Purdue to win...no one except Tyler. He even camped out overnight to be first in line to buy a ticket to the game, which at that time was far from being a sellout! His battle with cancer and his love for Purdue football rallied his team, and despite the odds, Perdue beat Ohio State!

Millions of people watched him interviewed by ESPN. His attitude in the face of cancer made people wonder how Tyler could have such a good attitude and be so strong. After Tyler's death on January 1, his pastor of 10 years said this, "I can tell you what made Tyler strong. Tyler loved Jesus, that's it, and it made him strong."

His parents said that on the day he learned that he had cancer, he had read 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 in his morning Bible reading. So when his parents told him about his diagnosis, he responded by quoting what he had read that morning.

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all

circumstances: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18.

"Tyler's strength didn't come from the prospect of healing. His hope didn't rise from the national support he received. His courage didn't come from personal grit or self-discipline, although he had both. Tyler's strength was rooted in the gospel. Tyler knew his greater need was to be right with God. He trusted in Jesus and his confidence and kindness overflowed from the forgiveness granted to him through Christ. That changed everything, including his perspective on cancer."

Tyler's pastor went on to say that Tyler had a passion for Jesus long before his cancer diagnosis. "Tyler loved Jesus Christ and he wanted to finish strong, and that's exactly what he did."

So, what about us? How will we face adversity in the new year? Will we face it with faith and determination despite our circumstances? Will we continue to have an attitude of faith even if things don't turn out the way we had hoped? Will we know the most important thing is being right with God?

I'm praying we will "be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might." (Ephesians 6:10) I'm praying we will all finish strong in 2019 as we love Jesus Christ with all our heart!
