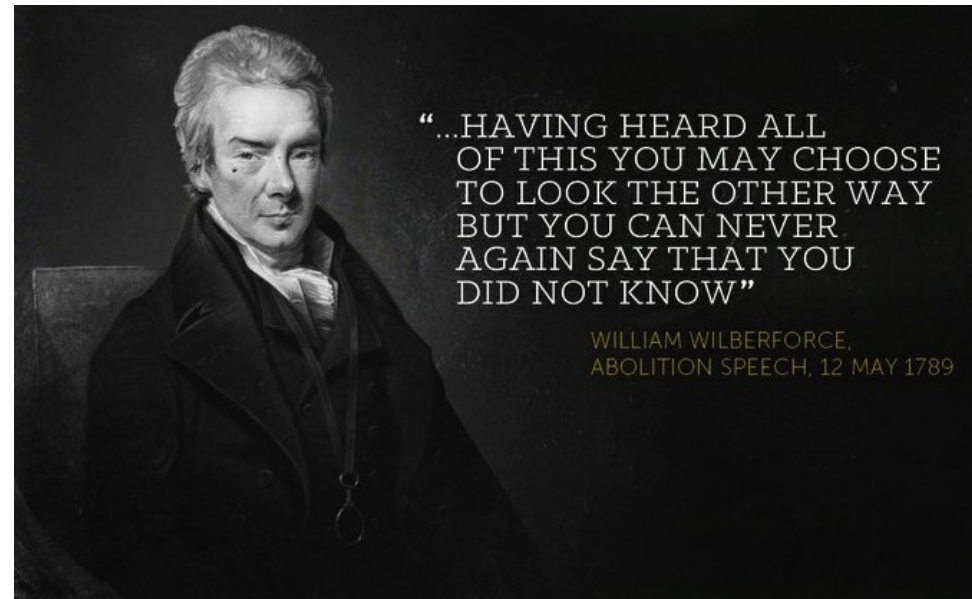

What to Do In An Unbelieving Culture

Let's face the facts, the majority culture has always resisted and rejected the God of the Bible. That's a historical fact. There have been times of revival, but they have been localized. There have been times historically

when the culture was more receptive to Christianity. Those times came when men and women were influenced by the preaching and teaching of the Word of God and formed prayer groups for the purpose of changing the culture through the gospel.

One such group in England was called "Clapham Sect." (Clapham is a district located in south west London.)

They were Christians, friends and supporters of William Wilberforce, a member of Parliament who over a period of about 30 yrs worked to eventually abolish slavery in England long before it happened in America.

"What held this group together was the desire to apply their faith in Jesus Christ to personal, social, political, national and international matters. The group made no claim to be theologians, yet they were people who regarded **prayer and Bible study** as serious matters. The Clapham group believed that they were representatives of God's kingdom on earth and the faithful stewards of all God had given them."

But just as some resist and reject **some will respond**. Our job is to utilize the Scriptures, times of

corporate prayer and the gospel to change our culture one person, one family at a time.

Jesus was opposed but He overcame the opposition of religion, government and those who rejected His message.

The apostles overcame the same opposition to establish churches that eventually carried the gospel to Western Europe. Then Western Europe eventually sent missionaries to America so we could carry the gospel to the ends of the earth!

What is the key to overcoming the resistance of the culture to the gospel? It's the preaching and teaching of the Bible, and committed believers joining together for prayer, then using the gospel to change our culture. That's always worked because it's God's plan!

Let's get busy with the plan!
