Bookstore:

February 7th book sale was a great success! Proceeds were \$1040. There were lots of new faces!

Our first internet sales check for January 2026 was \$109.04.

The 1st quarter cull will be on Saturday, March 28th.

Please note the changes to the book sale dates:

- We added August 1st (Manchester Days). The big BOOK SALE sign will be placed at the entrance, and the bookstore will be staffed from 9 am to 3 pm, with credit card payments accepted via Square. No additional tables will be set up.
- We removed the September 12th date and added October 3rd to align with October Fest.

Pairing our sales with other events seems to significantly boost our sales, as we experience increased foot traffic.
