

Friends of the Manchester Library: typical Annual Budget

With income from:

Fundraisers like the Salmon Bake, other special events

Sales of Books, Plants, Raffles

Donations

FOML pays typical operating expenses

Building and grounds maintenance and repairs, insurance **\$6,000**

Utilities: **\$8,500+**

Library programs: **\$6,000**

Miscellaneous (volunteer and staff recognition, postage, fundraiser costs and advertising, cost of goods to sell, supplies) **\$5,000**

Every year FOML needs to raise \$25,000 to \$30,000 to keep the library open

The new Library Addition includes Solar panels:

\$ saved since original installation on Aug 4, 2021: \$994

Kilowatt hours produced since 8/4/21: 8286 kWh

Pounds of CO₂ production avoided since 8/4/21: 16,323 lbs

Our 25 solar panels, rated at 8.75 kW d/c output, manufactured by Sun Power, installed by Power Trip Energy, and funded 100% by a generous Green Power grant from Puget Sound Energy.

With the library re-opening on June 19 we have had the air-conditioning running every day. On most sunny days, the solar panels have produced enough power to fully cover all the power used!
