Hazelnut Toscakake - Submitted by Christopher Mohs, Vikingland Lodge 1-495, Detroit Lakes, MN A twist on the classic Norwegian almond cake

Preheat the oven to 350°F (175°C). For the cake, melt butter and

set aside to cool. Whisk the eggs and sugar together until light yellow and fluffy. Add the flour and melted butter until just combined. Pour the batter into a springform pan lined with parchment paper and bake for about 45 minutes. Check to see if it's done by inserting a toothpick or wooden skewer into the cake. If it comes out clean, the cake is done. If batter sticks, bake for an additional 5 minutes and test again.

When done, remove the cake from the oven but leave it in the springform pan. For the topping, place all topping ingredients

into a saucepan and bring to a boil. Once a boil is achieved, immediately pour the mixture onto the cake and spread evenly across the top. Return the cake to the oven and continue baking; only using the top heat (broiler) if possible until it looks golden brown, about 5-10 minutes.

Remove from the oven and allow it to cool before removing from the springform pan. Enjoy! *This recipe and more may be found on Christopher's blog Pumpernickel & Rye.*

Deafening Denizens of the Deep

Sperm whales (or *spermhval* in Norwegian) are probably familiar to most of us, whether that's thanks to National Geographic or Moby Dick. Their massive rectangular heads and vast size are unmistakable. These whales can be found in Norwegian waters year-round, so any time is a good time to go on a whale safari!

What may be less commonly known is that sperm whales are the LOUD-EST animal on the planet. They make a lot of different vocalizations like creaking, trumpeting, and squealing—but what you need to watch out for is

the clicking! Sperm whales make clicking sounds that can reach 230 decibels. That's loud enough to actually deafen a person diving with these giant mammals. Divers have also reported partial paralysis and general body heating when exposed to the overwhelming volume and concussion of these clicks.

The Influence of Pop Band a-ha on Norway's Electric Car Industry

In the 1980s, Norway's environmental movement attempted to push electric vehicle technology to no avail. In a stroke of genius, Professor Harald N. Rostvik, from the University of Stavanger, decided to recruit the country's biggest pop group, a-ha, to be the face of the movement. After traveling to the Tour de Sol exhibition in 1989 where they witnessed an electric Fiat Panda, the band imported and started driving a similar car in Norway to show the country that there is a better alternative to polluting fossil fuel vehicles. Part of the band's campaign involved civil disobedience, such as getting fines through toll booths or refusing to pay vehicle taxes. The stance was that this type of sustainable travel should not be subject to such fees, making it that more enticing.



After several years of embarrassing the government with their charades, Norway adopted the incentives that the campaign had advocated for, such as free parking, zero tax, and free ferry travel. Today, Norway is a different place with over a half a million EVs and 78% of new car sales in the last year being pure electric.

We were saddended to hear of the passing of District 6 President, Bob Sather. District 6 Secretary Nancy Madson informed us that Lis Barca was officially installed as president by International Director Luella Grangaard at a Zoom board meeting on January 8, 2023. Lis Barca had been vice president for the same time that Bob had been president since June 2022. Zone 3 Director Laurie Mittelstadt will be installed as vice president, at the Zoom district board meeting on February 5. Please welcome and support Lis and Laurie in their new positions.

Below is taken from Bob's obituary, provided by Lotte Sather. Our thoughts and prayers are with Lotte and her family.

Robert Einar "Bob" Sather passed to heaven, January 3, 2023, at age 80, after a valiant fight with liver cancer. He lived his Norwegian heritage and loved Sons of Norway. Bob was proud to have been elected President of District Six and had planned to lead District Six into the future.

Bob was born November 16, 1942, into Sons of Norway, as his mother Ruth was pregnant with him, when Victory Lodge 43, Vallejo was instituted, and his parents were charter members. Bob's first Sons of Norway financial product was life insurance purchased when he was 6 months old. He became an adult member in 1964.

Bob met wife Lotte at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Tacoma, Washington, where they both sang in the church choir. Bob was in the U.S. Army stationed at Fort Lewis and Gloria Dei was Lotte's church. They married in that same church July 18, 1964, and moved to Vallejo in 1965, where they lived and raised their family until 2004, when they moved to Rio Vista.

Bob became an officer in Victory Lodge and attended his first District Six Convention in 1974 as a delegate. He attended all District Six conventions to follow, except 1990, when his mother's family planned a reunion. At the District Six Convention in 1980, Bob was elected Youth Director and has held various District offices over the past 42 years. He also served as an International Delegate and on numerous District and International committees.

Bob led a big life of sharing his time and leadership talents with family, friends, and many organizations. Bob was also an avid bowler and swimmer, competing in both well into his 70s.

Bob is survived by his wife and partner of 60 years, Charlotte Louise Plischke known as "Lotte," their son Erik Einar and daughter Anne Marie, along with seven grandchildren, his sister Pauline Brownwood and her children.

According to his wishes, Bob will be buried in the Veterans Cemetery in Dixon, California.
