Wellness Guarantee

The puppy named above is guaranteed to be in good health and free of any genetic diseases. This genetic health guarantee is for three years from date of purchase. Buyer agrees to have the puppy checked by a licensed veterinarian within three days of taking possession of the puppy. Should the veterinarian find anything that is life threatening or substantially threatens the quality of life of the puppy The Hart of Fair Bluff Collies will replace the puppy with another puppy of equal value in that litter, provided the buyer provides a letter from the treating veterinarian, and the puppy is returned within that time period or buyer may choose to wait until a future litter, within one year, is born. Common puppy ailments such as, giardia, clostridia, coccidia, worms, mites, fleas, ticks are not covered under this

guarantee. The puppy has been examined at 6-8 weeks of age by the Seller's vet, and all common puppy illnesses/issues have been addressed and preventative measures taken. Any signs of lethargy, lack of appetite or desire to drink water, diarrhea (particularly with blood and/or mucus), or vomiting must be reported to the breeder and your vet immediately.

Items included with puppies....

- AKC Package (blue folder, includes one month of health insurance)
- Registration Papers (already registered)
- Puppy Bag
- Sample Food (Diamond Puppy)

Four Month Protection Period

Buyer understands that the puppy under four months of age, has not completed a full series of shots. Buyer understands that there could be consequences of taking a puppy into the public area of catching a disease of which the puppy while having received vaccinations, the series is not complete, and the puppy could therefore catch a communicable disease/virus. It is recommended that the buyer not bring the puppy into areas where infected or unvaccinated animals have been causing parvovirus, giardia, coccidia, ect. Any illness contracted from buyers decision to not follow this advice, will void this guarantee.

Three Year Health Guarantee

What is covered.....

-Eye Disorders- congenital defect of the eye causing progressive blindness in one or both eyes. Common Collie Eye disorders CEA or Collie Eye Anomaly, PRA-rcd2 or a rod cone disease. Diagnosis needs to be verified by a board certified Veterinary Ophthalmologist.

-Genetically caused hip or elbow dysplasia, provided that the puppy has not been overweight, or had any physical injuries, exposed to unhealthy environmental conditions, trauma, abuse, or whose issues are unknown or may have an environmental link, which may have caused hip/elbow dysplasia.

-Cardiac disorders requiring surgery or a heart disorder or life long medication which must be diagnosed by a board certified canine cardiologist.

What is not covered....

This warranty does not cover viral illnesses, infections, improper bites, hernias, hypoglycemia, worms, giardia or coccidiosis. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, plants, chemicals, or other items, physical injuries or issues whose cause is unknown, or may have an environmental link or illness from unknown causes that are not preventable by genetic pre screening, including but not limited to, cancerous growths. Not included in this guarantee are health problems arising from trauma, abuse, or failing to maintain general healthcare of this dog, including allowing the dog to become overweight. Also not included is injury to bones or joints from over-exercise. Since exposure to improper or harsh environments are explicitly excluded from warranty of hip or elbow dysplasia. Veterinary records must be provided to the Seller if requesting refund or replacement. Under no circumstances shall the Seller be liable to the Buyer, or to any third party for a dog that has been subjected to abuse, accident, negligence, or misuse.

Buyers Responsibilities/Buyer agrees to

- Feed a quality dog food
- Maintain the dog in good health
- Provide routine preventative health care
- Maintain heartworm and flea/tick control schedules
- Not allow the dog to be overweight or over exercised

- Not subject the dog to harsh conditions
- Agrees to not allow the dog to extreme heat or severe weather conditions.
- Will not tie the dog outside
- Provide a minimum obedience training
- Agrees to not rehome the dog. If the buyer can no longer care for the dog, the dog is to be returned to the breeder. Under no circumstance is the dog to be released to a humane society, animal control, or foster care.
- Not to keep the dog outside overnight

Failure to do any of the above, voids this guarantee

Spay/Neuter Agreement

Buyer understands that this puppy is not to be bred, and agrees to spay/neuter the puppy between the ages of 18 months and 2 years old for a traditional spay or 12 months of age for a vasectomy/tubal ligation.

Re-Homing

If an unforeseen event arises, such as the Buyer is unable to continue to keep the puppy/dog, Buyer agrees to contact Seller immediately and Seller will assist Buyer in finding an approved home. Seller agrees to take actual possession of the puppy/dog and keeps puppy/dog until an approved home is found. Seller will provide Buyer with a bill of sale. Buyer understands that this price may be considerably lower than the purchase price. Seller will return any money minus the cost of keeping the puppy/dog such as food, grooming, flea/tick, heartworm preventative, and vet care. Buyer understands that if the dog/puppy ends up in a shelter, all fees that may have been acquired for the dog/puppy, no monies will be returned.

Non-Transferable

This guarantee is non transferable and is between the Seller and original Buyer only.

No Other Warranties

It is further understood and agreed that no warranty or representation has been made with respect to the described Puppy except as set forth herein. Buyer agrees to hold Seller harmless and free from any liability from the time Buyer has taken possession of the Puppy.

Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the entire Agreement between the parties, and there are no other agreements, expressed or implied, unless included in this Agreement or by a writing signed by both parties and made a part hereof.
