ORDINANCE NO. 05-1

ROAD CLOSING AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

AND NOW, this 9th day of February, 2005, the Supervisors of Howe Township, Forest County, Pennsylvania, do hereby ENACT AND ORDAIN as follows:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance adopted April 10th, 1996, entitled Road Closing Ordinance 96-2, the Supervisors of Howe Township imposed weight limits upon certain Township highways; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have recently commissioned the performance of a subsequent engineering and traffic study, and as a consequence of that study, have determined that the imposition of an additional weight limit is appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Supervisors do ENACT AND ORDAIN and it is ENACTED AND ORDAINED for Howe Township, Forest County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ARTICLE I

Section 2 of the Howe Township Road Closing Ordinance 96-2 is hereby modified by adding to the end of Section 2, thereof, the following sentence: "Additionally, all of Duhring Road, Bean Farm Road, Cooper Tract Road, Byromtown Road, Watson Farm Road, Sheffield Junction Road and Fork Run Road, each to the township line, is hereby closed, for all months of the year, to motor vehicles having a gross weight in excess of twenty thousand (20,000) pounds."

ARTICLE II

In all other respects, the terms of the Road Closing Ordinance are hereby ratified.

ARTICLE III

This Amendment shall become effective five (5) days after the date of adoption.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Supervisors of Howe Township have caused this Ordinance to be adopted this 9th day of February, 2005.
