NOTICE OF RACE

BYC and Fleet 35 are proud to present the 4th annual Penguin Revival Regatta.

1. RULES

1.1. This Regatta is not a class sanctioned Regatta. The “Penguin Revival” is a Classic and modern regatta designed to get Penguin Dinghies back on the Toms River. The Regatta shall be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the IPCDA Class rules except whereas modified by this NOR and SI.

1.2. Weight, Measurements and Equipment. – **There will be minimal adherence to the Penguin class rules regarding weights and measures.** However, the listed safety equipment, items 5-8, are required and will be checked as part of “check-in”

1.2.1. “Minimum Class crew weight” is 290 lbs. for classic boats and 310 lbs. for modern boats.

1.2.2. (Modern boat definition includes Burtis, Innovator and Freedom hulls. Class Measurer or appointee shall make classification decisions)

1.2.3. “Minimum Class hull weight” is 140 lbs. Excess Hull weight may be applied to the crew weight.

1.2.4. Up to 40lbs of non-floatable ballast with any additional weight made up with floatable ballast is permitted to meet the minimum weight requirement.

1.3. Equipment

1.3.1. Anchors are not required.

1.3.2. **One functional paddle is required.**

1.3.3. **A painter not less than 25' in length and 3/16" in diameter is required.**

1.3.4. **A Coast Guard approved PFD is required for all skippers and crew.**

1.3.5. **An adequate means of bailing**

1.4. No-Capsize rule in effect. Any boat that capsizes during a race, as defined by the mast hitting the water, shall retire from that race.

1.5. Advertising and Sponsors: The regatta is Designated Category A in accordance with Rule 79 of the RRS, there will be no penalty for items that are approved by the Organizing Authority.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND FEES

2.1. Penguin Revival: For skippers sailing with non-family member crew (under the age of 18), the name, emergency contact and signature of a parent or guardian will be required for participation.

2.2. Entry Fee \$60 for skipper and crew, \$50 for Skipper only sailing with ballast.

2.2.1. Includes: Regatta, Lunch and Shirt for skipper and crew.

2.3. Please submit a ITC (Intent to compete) form and register on site the Morning-of.

2.3.1. (ITC forms are located on the last page of this NOR and are requested to be submitted as soon as possible prior to the regatta so we can accurately forecast attendance and ensure proper regatta shirt sizes)

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The sailing instructions will be available online at <https://beachwoodyachtclub.com/regatta> and at the registration table the day of the regatta.

6. Registration

6.1. Registration can be made on the Beachwood Yacht Club Regatta Page Via a Google Form prior to May16th, 2 weeks before the regatta.

6.2. Registration payments can be made via Zelle, Mail or Day-of Cash or Check. Payment Details on Google Form.

7. VENUE

7.1. The regatta will be held at:

7.2. Beach access is behind the club at the end of Cedar St.

7.3. Racing will be held on the Toms River. Race area will depend on weather and wind velocity.

8. THE COURSES

8.1. The diagrams in the Sailing Instructions show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be rounded, and the side on which each mark is to be rounded to.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. The scoring system will be RSS Appendix A, Low point systems.
- 9.2. One Race Constitutes a Regatta.
- 9.3. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of race scores.
- 9.4. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding worst score.
- 9.5. The race committee has the authority to hold as many races as possible, weather permitting. One race may constitute a regatta but anticipate 5-6 races Saturday.
