BUILDING FOUNDATIONS FOR GALLIA COUNTY YOUTH

Since 2019, Career Connections has been a partner in the Gallia County Job and Family Services Summer Youth Employment Program. This amazing program, organized by Gallia County Job & Family Services, taps into funding available through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services to offer a summer work experience that is geared toward providing onthe-job training, income-earning opportunities, and life skills necessary to build a foundation for a solid future. This year, they even have a financial educator visiting participants at the job site (to remove transportation barriers) and offer advice on how to open a bank account, save money, set a budget, etc.

While our role is just being the employer of record and making sure the timesheets are filled out and paychecks are delivered, we love being involved and watching these participants, ages 14 to 24, who start off apprehensive and unsure gain confidence and pride for what they have learned and experienced. We have hired and are paying over 100 young people this summer, which has a huge impact on these workers, not to mention the economy of Gallia County.
