CAPREOL MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT RULES

• All Hockey Canada, OHF and NOHA rules will apply. Capreol will appoint all officials. Tournament Committee will deal with all major infractions.

• Fighting, abusive language or intent to injure penalties will not be tolerated. OHF suspension list will be used. Additionally, the Tournament Committee will determine extra suspensions. Players and coaches could be suspended for the balance of the tournament.

• All teams and players must register ½ hour prior to their first game.

Official NOHA rooster as to be given prior to the first game

• All teams must be prepared to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time.

• Once a 5-goal differential exists between teams, the clock will run. If the difference goes back to 4 goals, then we will continue using stop time.

• In the event of conflicting colors, the home team will be responsible for changing sweaters

- Teams will be allowed a 30 second time out in any game
- Point System: Win = 2 points, Tie = 1 point, Loss = 0 points.
 - If teams are tied in points after round robin play, the ties will be

broken by:

1st) Head to head record

2nd) Most wins

3rd) % of goals for versus goals against as determined by rule 19

4th) Least penalized team

5th) Coin Toss

• Overtime in Championship & Consolation final games will consist of 4 on 4 plus a goalie for 5 minutes, sudden death. Then 3 on 3 for 5 minutes, sudden death. Teams do not change ends in overtime. If still tied, there will be a shoot out.

• Shoot-Out. Pick 3 players and each player receives 1 shot for a total of 3 shots per side, most goals wins. If still tied, then sudden death shoot out begins until there is a winner. Any player receiving a 10 minute misconduct in the 2 overtime periods will not be permitted to participate in the shoot out.

• 4 penalty rule is an injection from the game

• The tournament Committee reserves the right to make decisions regarding interpretation of all tournament rules and regulations.

No protest allowed.

The NOHA three stick infraction ejection rule will apply. No parents allowed on the ice at any time.

Refund Policy

- 1. Teams withdrawing from the tournament prior to the 30-day limit will receive a refund of the entry fee less \$60.00 for administration.
- 2. Teams withdrawing from the tournament within the 30-day limit will receive a 50% refund of their entry fee.
