Parent/Guardian Agreement and Code of Conduct

As part of registering my child/children with the Hernando Soccer Club, I, the parent/legal guardian of the following child/children (please print first and last names below), agree to abide by the following Hernando Soccer Club rules and regulations.

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1. **I will notify the Hernando Soccer Club's recreational registrar if I remove my child from the league.** The following schedule will be followed in regard to fee reimbursement:
 - *Prior to the final day of September of the current year, the full fee will be reimbursed.*
 - *Between October 1 and October 14 of the current year, 50% of the fee will be reimbursed.*
 - *After October 14 of the current year, no fees will be reimbursed.*

 2. **I acknowledge that my child will be placed on a recreational soccer team using a system called a blind draft.** This is a blind draw based on age and experience. Once my child is placed on a team, they cannot switch teams for any reason. I agree that I will not ask my child to be placed on a team with another player because of carpooling or any other reasons, or to be placed on a specific team because my child or I have another commitment on a specific night of the week. If, once my child is placed on a team, I decide to remove my child from the league, the above fee reimbursements will apply (see #1).

 3. **I agree that my family will be responsible for volunteering at least 2 hours in the concession stand during the soccer season.** I agree to pay a \$25.00 surcharge at the time of registration. Upon completing 2 hours of volunteer time in the concession stand, I will be credited this surcharge the following year (or, upon written request, refunded if my child does not register the following year). Failure to fulfill the volunteer commitment may subject me to this \$25.00 surcharge and an additional \$25.00 charge if I did not complete my volunteer hours the previous season. I agree that my child(ren) will be expected to participate in league-sponsored fundraisers.

 4. **I agree to abide by the following 8 Hernando Soccer Club points of conduct:**
 - a. I accept responsibility to ensure that my child will abide by their player agreement.
 - b. I will treat the coaches, players, referees, and league officials with respect and always conduct myself civilly.
 - c. Unsportsmanlike behavior, arguing with referees, coaches, league officials, using foul or abusive language, or conduct infringing on the enjoyment of the game by other spectators or players will result in my being asked to leave the field.
 - d. My continued lack of self-control may result in my being asked to leave the league, and possibly my child's.
 - e. I understand that alcohol is not permitted on the property and that intoxication will not be tolerated. I will be asked to leave the property if I violate this.
 - f. I understand that smoking is permitted only in the parking lot.
 - g. I understand that no pets are permitted on the property.

- h. I understand that by signing below, I accept responsibility for my actions and those of any other spectators I bring to my child's games or practices.
- 5. **I agree and acknowledge that HSC charges a \$30.00 returned check fee** and that I MUST pay this fee along with the amount of the original check in cash immediately upon being informed of the returned check.
- 6. **Hernando Soccer Club strives to celebrate the accomplishments of its teams and players** by occasionally sharing information with the community. To do this, HSC may use team/player names, photographs, and/or video in our yearly program, on our website, on social media, in press releases to local media, and local advertising. We allow HSC to publish and/or display such information.

Disciplinary Policy

Hernando Soccer Club is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all players, families, coaches, and officials. Parents and guardians understand that violations of the Player Code of Conduct or behavior that is disruptive, threatening, or unsportsmanlike may result in disciplinary action.

Disciplinary matters will be reviewed by club leadership and handled in accordance with the Hernando Soccer Club Disciplinary Policy. Actions may include a warning, temporary suspension from practices or games, or removal from the program depending on the nature and severity of the incident.

Parents and guardians agree to support the club in upholding these standards of conduct.
