I am the Coordinator of the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Drive in SW Placer County, CA. I am writing this letter on behalf of Bryan Sedway. I would like to commend his efforts during our 2022 Marine Corps Toys for Tots campaign. Bryan Sedway was influential in conducting a successful toy collection drive from his high school, Granite Bay High in Granite Bay, CA. This is the second year, from October to December, that Bryan has volunteered in this capacity for Marine CorpsToys for Tots.

Bryan collected 229 toys during the 2021 season. In his second year, he collected 543 toys for families in need during the holiday season. Bryan organized and led a special event for the three days after Thanksgiving. During that event, he dressed up as Santa and waved at each car and person that came by. The comprehensive local promotion of his event brought in an impressive 385 of the total 543 donations in Granite Bay last Christmas. The remaining 158 donated toys were donated at his high school and various businesses in Granite Bay. Bryan also stepped up to collect more toys when new collection sights were added.

Because of Bryan's efforts and leadership, he inspired me to get more high school students involved in our collection efforts. We used his example to get four more high schools involved.
