

This Deed, made and entered into this twenty fifth day of February eighteen hundred and seventy by and between Charles P Ingalls and Caroline E Ingalls his wife, of the County of Montgomery State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and Adairmontine Johnson of Chariton County State of Missouri party of the second part, witnesses; that the said party of the first part, in consideration of One thousand and Eighty Dollars, to them paid by the said party of the second part; the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, etc by these presents, Grant, Bargain and Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part the following tract of land situated in said County of Chariton and State of Missouri viz: The East half of the South East quarter of Section numbered thirty-two 22, in Township numbered fifty-six 56 N of Range numbered thirteen 13, containing Eighty acres, to his heirs more or less, the above consideration is the amount paid by the first part still due party of the second part, for the above described piece of land which they purchased of said second party, during the year 1868, and the object of this Deed is to cancel said purchase and reinvest said second party with full title to said above described piece of land, To Have and To Hold the same, together with all the rights, immunities, privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever: the said parties of the first part hereby covenanting that they and their heirs, executors and administrators shall and will warrant and defend the title to the premises to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
