

This Indenture, made this Sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven between Henry O. Quinn, and Polly M. Quinn his wife, of the County of Poplar, and State of Wisconsin, parties of the first part, and Charles R. Magalls of the same place, party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, and sold, and by these presents do remise, release and quit-claim, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Poplar, and State of Wisconsin, and described as follows to wit: The South half (1/2) of the South West quarter (1/4) of Section No. twenty seven (27) in Township No. twenty four (24) of Range No. fifteen (15) west containing Eighty (80) acres according to the Government Survey.

To Have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the Appurtenances and Privileges thereunto belonging, and all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest and Claim whatsoever of the said parties of the first part, either in Law or Equity, in and to the above described premises, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
