Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Hundred and twelve 50/100 Dollars therein hand paid, by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained sold, remised, released, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever All that certain piece of parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Pepin, and State of Wisconsin, and described as follows, to wit:

The North half "1/2" of the South West quarter "1/4" of Section No Twenty seven "27" in Township No Twenty four "24" of Range No Fifteen "15" West, containing eighty acres according to Government Survey thereof.

Together with all and singular the Hereditaments and Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, of the said party of the first part, either in Law or Equity, either in possession or expectancy of, in and to the above bargained premises, and their Hereditaments and Appurtenances. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises as above described, with the Hereditaments and Appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

And the Said Gustaf Bijschot for his heirs, executors and administrators, doth covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents, he is well seized of the premises above described, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in the law, in fee simple, and that the same are free and clear from all incumbrances whatever,

and that the above bargained premises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming the whole or any part thereof. He will forever WARRANT AND DEFEND.
