ment, bond or otherwise to convey as aforesaid, in such subdivi-
sions, and to such person or persons, and at such price or prices,
and on such terms as he the said Attorney may think expedi-
ent. All the Real Estate belonging, or in anywise appertaining
unto the said Charles P. Ingalls and Caroline his wife, sit-
uated in Pepin County, Wisconsin, and they hereby authorize
their said Attorney for them, and in their name and as
their act, and deed, to sign, execute, acknowledge, and
deliver such Deed or Deeds and Conveyances or Conveyances
as aforesaid for the sale and disposal thereof, or of any part
thereof, to collect all moneys due from said sales, hereby
