This Indenture, Made the twenty eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Eight between Gustaf Reynholt Gustafson of the County of Pepin and State of Wisconsin party of the first part, and Charles P. Ingalls of the same place party of the second part

Witnesseth, That the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred and twelve 50/100 Dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, and sell, unto the said part of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Pepin and State of Wisconsin and described as follows to wit:

The South half (1/2) of the South West quarter 1/4 of Section No. Twenty Seven (27) in Township No. Twenty four (24) of Range No. Fifteen (15) West containing Eighty (80) acres according to the government Survey thereof.

To Have and to Hold the above bargained premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said part of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. Provided always, and these presents are upon this express condition, that if the said Gustaf Reynholt Gustafson part of the first part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, to the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of Nine Hundred and twelve 50/100 Dollars

according to the condition of two certain Notes bearing even date herewith, executed by the said part of the first part to the said part of the second part, as collateral security, then these presents, and the said shall cease, and be null and void:

And the said Gustaf Reynholt Gustafson do hereby covenant and agree that he will pay all taxes and assessments of every nature that may be assessed on said premises, previous to the day appointed in pursuance of any law of the State for the sale of lands for taxes. And also will pay the sum of twenty five dollars and Solicitor's fees, in case of foreclosure of this mortgage; by reason of the non-performance of any of the conditions hereof by said part of the first part. And in case of the non-payment of said sum, or any part thereof, at the time or times above limited for the payment thereof, or in case of the non-payment of any taxes that may be assessed on said premises in manner aforesaid; then, and in either case, it shall at any time be lawful for the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, and the said part of the first part do hereby covenant and agree, and by these presents empower and authorize the said part of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, to grant, bargain, sell, release and convey, the said premises, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, at Public Auction or Vendue, and on such sale to make and execute to the purchaser or purchasers, his, her or their heirs and assigns forever, good, ample and sufficient Deeds of Conveyance in the Law, pursuant to the Statute in such case made and provided; and out of the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the principal and interest which shall then be due on the said Notes together with the costs and charges, and the said sum of twenty five dollars, Solicitor's fees, as aforesaid; rendering the surplus moneys, if any, there be, to the said part of the first part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, after deducting the cost of such Vendue as aforesaid.
