What is a Speech and Language Development Screening?

A speech and language development screening provides a quick “snapshot” of your child’s speech and language abilities. A speech language pathologist will ask your child some questions, show them some objects and pictures, and make notes about their speech and language development. After the screening is completed, you will be contacted to discuss results. A screening is a great tool for determining whether or not your child would benefit from a full speech and language evaluation. It serves as an early intervention tool to help us stay proactive and keep us aware of any potential delays.
