Match Day Preparation

Before the match



To Do



Contact the opposition Manager 7 days prior to the match (Referee within 24 hours of notification)

Tell them:

- Day/Date & KO time (if different to standard time, then you'll need opposition agreement)
- Kit colours
- That a Squad ID check will take place (bring Club Portal squad list)

If you can't contact the opposition or have not received a reply by Wed for Sat /Sun match, contact their Club Sec.

If still no response contact the League Fix Sec:
mwfixsec@gmail.com

If a referee is appointed :

Tell them:

- Day/Date & KO time
- Confirm how to pay (cash on the day or via their bank)

Be prepared to pay the Ref BEFORE the match kick-off

To Do	✓
Set up a DTA (for Coaches and team players) AND Respect line (for supporters)	
Welcome Pay ref BEFORE game starts (League rule) and give him/her the MATCH ball, also letting the referee know who will 'run the line'	
Conduct a Squad list check 5mins prior to kick-off If ID check is not completed, then the game is NOT official AND SHOULD NOT BE PLAYED AS A LEAGUE MATCH. It can be played as a friendly. - Inform your Club Sec The game will NOT be re-dated (the non defaulting team will be awarded the points or tie (cup game)

To Do



Respond to the FULL-TIME text and enter the score (within 2 hours of the final whistle)

OR

Report the match details via the FA FULL-TIME Website (no later than Wed after the match has finished)

Match Day App* IS NOT THE CORRECT way to complete your match report. It does not always fully complete the requirement on Full-Time.

*Match Day App is not a league app. FA Full-Time website is the prescribe vehicle to report the match day scores and associated details

It is possible that a charge (from the league) can be imposed for incomplete details.

Non Fulfillment

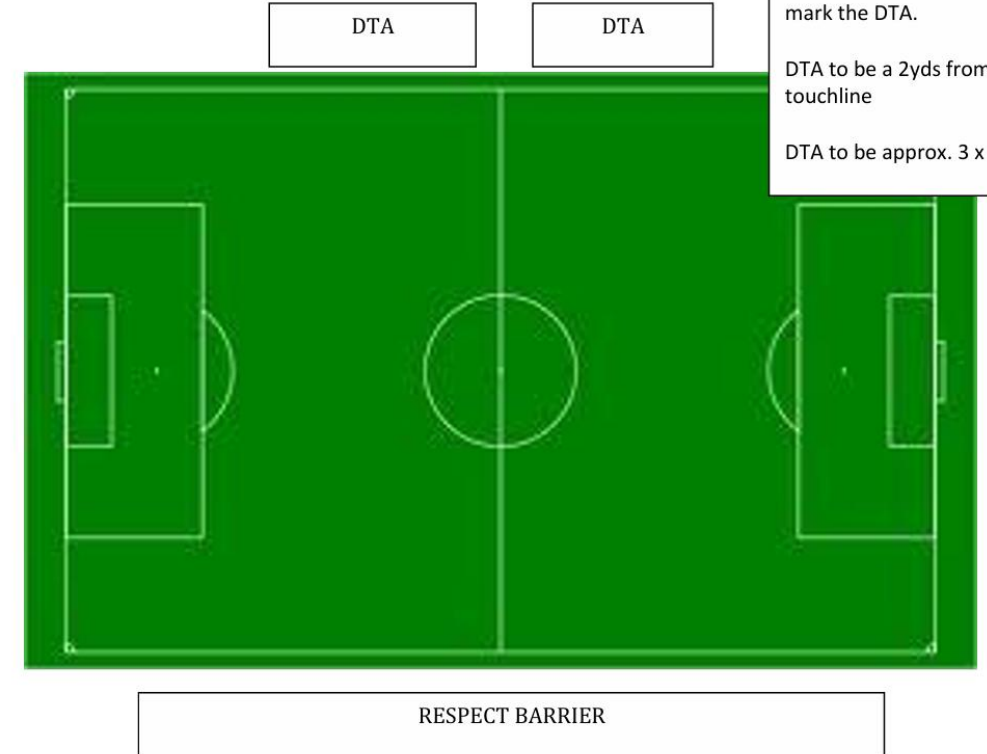


Non – Fulfillment (NF) of a match	✓
<p>There are only three valid reasons for postponement of a match</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(1) Cup match (all cup matches take priority over league games)(2) Unfit Pitch(3) School activity e.g. Schools tournament	
<p>The link below is for the online NF Form</p>	
<p>Online Forms Mid Wilts Youth & Minor Football League</p>	
<p>The game may then be re-dated by the league (pending league acceptance of non fulfillment reasons)</p> <p>Don't re-date the match yourself unless approved by league</p>	
<p>In the event of a non played match BOTH teams must complete the form (failure to do so may result in a fine)</p>

Pitch Set-Up

Diagram to illustrate suggested set up for the DTA/RESPECT Barrier



Notes:
Flat marker cones to be used to mark the DTA.

DTA to be a 2yds from the touchline

DTA to be approx. 3 x 6yds

Notes:

RESPECT Barrier (can be marked lines or a barrier or cones) to be approx. 3-5yds from touchline and not to extend as far as corner flag area

ALL spectators must remain behind the Barrier during the match.

NO ONE (inc. coaching staff) is allowed behind the goals during the match.
