- "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE" (John 6:35) And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. (John 6:41) The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven. (John 6:48) I am that bread of life. (John 6:51) I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.
- "I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD" (John 8:12) Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 9:5) As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world. (John 12:46) I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- "I AM THE DOOR OF THE SHEEP" (John 10:7) Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. (John 10:9)
- "I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD" (John 10:10-11) The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. {11} I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (John 10:14)
- "I AM THE SON OF GOD" (John 10:36) Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?
- "I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE" (John 11:25-26) Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: {26} And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
- "I AM MASTER AND LORD" (John 13:13) Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.
- "I AM THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE" (John 14:6) Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- "I AM NOT OF THE WORLD" (John 17:14) I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (John 17:16) They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- "I AM KING OF THE JEWS" (John 18:37) Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice. (John 19:21)
- "I AM ALPH AND OMEGA, THE BEGINNING AND THE ENDING...THE ALMIGHTY" (Rev 1:8) I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. (Rev.1:8; 21:6)
- "I AM ALPHA AND OMEGA, THE FIRST AND THE LAST" (Rev 1:11) Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. (Rev. 1:11; 1:17; 22:13)
- "I AM" THE ROOT AND OFFSPRING OF DAVID and THE BRIGHT AND MORNING STAR" (Rev 22:16) I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.
- "I AM" HE THAT LIVETH AND WAS DEAD... "I AM" ALIVE FOR EVERMORE (Rev 1:18) "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death." "I AM" HE! (John 8:24) "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins." (Rev.2:23) "I AM" HE which searcheth the reins (inmost being of soul) and hearts..."

GOD THE GREAT "I AM"

JESUS IS GOD MANIFEST IN THE FLESH - (1 Tim 3:16) "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory." One of the names given to God and Christ is "THE WORD" (John 1:1-3; Rev.19-13) - (John 1:10-14) (John 1:14) "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth." (Phil.2:5-11) "HRIST BEING IN "THE FORM OF GOD" ... "WAS MADE IN THE LIKNESS OF MEN" (Phil 2:8-9) " I being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. {9} Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:" (This is God's Gospel Message that Saves the Lost - 1 Cor.15:1-3; Romans 1:16-17); Note conversation of Jesus and Philip (John 14:6-9) "he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father v.9, 7." - Isaiah the Prophet called Christ: (Isa.9:6) "THE MIGHTY GOD", "The Everlasting Father" - (The Trinity - Father - Son - Holy Spirit are ONE (John 5:7; John 10:27-30, 30) - Christ Being In "THE FORM OF GOD" "Was Made In The Likeness of Men" (Phil 2:5-11)

(Mat 1:21-23) And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. {22} Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, {23} Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. (God manifest in the flesh)

CHRIST BEING GOD MANIFEST IN THE FLESH IS THE CREATOR OF ALL THINGS God's dear Son is the IMAGE OF THE INVISIBLE GOD V.15 - (Col 1:12-22) Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: {13} Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: {14} In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: {15} Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: {16} For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: {17} And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. {18} And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. {19} For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; {20} And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself, by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. {21} And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled {22} In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:

(Hebrews 1:1-10) God reveals Christ as the "BRIGHTNESS OF HIS GLORY and the EXPRESS IMAGE OF HIS PERSON" (Heb 1:1-4) "God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, {2} Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; {3} Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; {4} Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they." (In verses 8 and 10 God calls Christ "GOD" and "LORD") Christ is the Image of God (Col.1:15; Heb.1:3; 2 Cor.4:4)

GOD THE GREAT "I AM" (Exo. 3:13-14 - Read the whole chapter) And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them? {14} And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you." - Jesus calls Himself "I Am" - (Christ is speaking to Jewish people about Abraham)

(John 8:54-59) Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: {55} Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying. {56} Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. {57} Then said the Jews unto him. Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? {58} Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. (59) Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by. Look at the "I AM'S of Christ:
