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FOREWORD

"Marriages of Some Virginia Residents, 1607-1800," is a series of books designed to cover a wider scope of information than other compilations limited to the Returns of Ministers, Parish Registers, or records of marriages in Court Houses. In each instance such marriages occurred within the boundaries of the Old Dominion.

The references and records in these volumes relate to three different classes of people:

1. Those who were married before settling in Virginia. References to these are of special aid to searchers tracing their ancestors back to the immigrant, as information given aids them in knowing the Colony in which to continue their search.
2. Those who were married in Virginia.
3. Those who married after removing from Virginia to another Colony or State. These are needed to assist in one of the most difficult problems in genealogy: identification of the native Colony of ancestors who died in Indiana, Illinois, Kentucky, Tennessee, Missouri, the Carolinas, Georgia, or elsewhere. This third class is a boon to compilers of a genealogy, guiding them to the various new areas to which descendants migrated.

COMPILATION TECHNIQUES

There has been no attempt to modernize the spelling. "Cook" is recorded as "Kuke," "McInteer" as "Manadear," preserving the phonetic spelling used by clerks, ministers or descendants.

Many items are a composite of data found in all references cited. Not all data were found in each reference. Some references to the same marriage presented vast differences as to dates, places, and, occasionally, as to names. References are cited separately for these. It is expected that current searchers can use these differences as clues for resolving the facts.

SCOPE OF RESEARCH

The search for Virginia marriages was begun as a personal hobby of the compiler and reached such vast proportions that the files contain over 150,000 cards. Three main ideas have been followed in accumulating information:

1. To identify the native Colony of settlers moving into southern and western areas.
2. To assemble information from family Bibles, traditions and personal knowledge as to marriages for which no official records exist. Migrants to the unpopulated areas took their Bibles with them and many county histories, published between 1850 and 1900, give statements of marriages before 1800. People of advanced years gave information from

their knowledge of the names of their grandparents, or even of their great-grandparents. These volumes can, in some measure, fill in the records so unfortunately destroyed in Virginia.

3. To prove "by inference" as many marriages as possible from abstracts of wills, deeds, court suits and records from Orphans' Courts.

MARRIAGES OF RECORD

Thousands of proven marriages are recorded in these volumes, as it is necessary to have all records easily available to know when this wide research has added something NEW to the facts.

HOW TO SECURE PROOF

The compiler of these volumes assumes no responsibility for the accuracy of the statements made. The information, in many instances, has been taken from lineages, histories, and listings made by people of varying ability and interest, sometimes based on family traditions. However, two to five statements from as many different sources are brought together into one paragraph, from which the current searcher may gather valuable clues leading to the irrefutable proof of the marriage. It is possible to secure photostats or certified copies of marriage bonds and records, and of DAR lineages, from their original sources.

BIBLIOGRAPHY

The listing of a book here means that these volumes include references from it, but it does not mean that all marriage information from that book has been compiled. Some rare books were used only for a brief period of time in a distant library — public or private.
