We find the following records of George Lewis paying his brothers and sisters (Abel, Ephraim, Isaiah, Peggy, and Polly) one Spanish-milled dollar for 50 acres of land that was part of an original grant for 100 acres to their father (Peter Lewis) in 1767. This land included the graves of Peter Lewis (although Peter was still alive at this time, so that's a little confusing) and his wife.
