REPORT OF THE INSPECTORS OF ELECTION

The Inspectors of Election, LLC (TIE)

Annual Meeting of Members and Election of Directors Wednesday, May 4, 2022

The Inspectors of Election, LLC (TIE) was contracted to serve as the oversight authority and independent, third-party election service for Huntington Townhomes Homeowners Association and were duly recognized by the Chair of the Annual Meeting. (CA Corp. Code §7614.)

As the duly appointed Inspector of Election at the Annual Meeting of Huntington Townhomes Homeowners Association held on the date noted above and all adjournments thereto, we hereby report as follows:

Quorum for the Annual Meeting:

- 1. The total Membership is 147.
- TIE determined that a quorum of <u>51% = 75 members</u> was obtained as defined by the Bylaws. A total of 85 members representing a weight of 57.8995 (57.9%) were represented by ballot.
- No Registration Envelopes were received without signature and could not be counted towards quorum or opened and tabulated.

Supervision of Election

- 1. TIE reviewed and supervised the registration process.
- 2. TIE determined the authenticity, validity, and effect of each ballot received prior to the close of the polls.
- 3. TIE determined all challenges and questions in any way arising in connection with the right to vote.
- 4. TIE determined if any ballots were invalid and were not counted for any reason.

Election Process

- 1. There were two (2) vacant positions open for election on the Board of Directors at the Meeting.
- 2. The terms for the open positions were for **three** years.
- 3. In the event of a tie vote between candidates for the final position, candidates may concede to one another, agree to allow for a flip of the coin to determine the outcome, or if neither of these is agreed to by all parties involved, a Run-Off Election will need to be held.
- 4. Huntington Townhomes Homeowners Association bylaws allow for cumulative voting.
- 5. The Candidates were as follows, and the votes received for each candidate are listed inline with their name.

6. TIE counted and tabulated all votes for the Election of Directors as follows:

Total votes cast in the election: 163 Weight of 111.12765 = ↓

Total votes possible in the election: 111.79782 ≤ 55.89891 weight X 2

Total votes withheld or not voted were: 67017

Total of ballots not counted: 3 *

*Reason for not counting ballots: Too many votes.
