SELECT BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 10, 2025

7:00 pm: R. Basford opened the meeting

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

October 27, 2025 Select Board Meeting minutes approved on motion made by B. Chase. Seconded by R. Basford.

APPROVAL OF WARRANTS:

- 1. R. Basford made a motion to approve Payroll Warrant #46 in the amount of \$8,938.35. Seconded by B. Chase.
- 2. R. Basford made a motion to approve Warrant #47 in the amount of \$203,156.82. Seconded by B. Chase.

APPOINTMENTS:

 Brady Thies spoke with the Board regarding the Town's permission to allow Hartt Electric to place a pole for CMP on his property on Johnson Flat Road. R. Basford made a motion to allow the pole placement, with approval from Road Commissioner, Kyle King. Seconded by B. Chase.

OLD BUSINESS:

- An ad was reviewed to place in The Rolling Thunder Express to thank Rancourt's Superior Landscaping for this past mowing season.
- An email from MMA was reviewed that explained the town would only need an ordinance prohibiting political signs
 on town property if the town's intent was to enforce fines/penalties. It was agreed to write up a simple policy banning
 signs on town property to review at the next Select Board meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Upcoming dates for the town were reviewed, with Town Meeting date set for March 20th & 21st, 2026. It was agreed to advertise in The Rolling Thunder Express.
- Sexton, Sherri Thornton and the Board agreed to take \$150 from the Cemeteries account, needed as additional
 funds to pay Grass Eaters Lawncare & Maintenance for an upcoming burial at the Village Cemetery. R. Basford made the
 motion to take \$150 from the Cemetery account. Seconded by B. Chase.
- 3. Sherri Thornton also discussed **Cemetery Fall Clean-up**. The Board agreed to help take down all the flags at the Cemeteries after Veterans Day and to order more flag holders.
- 4. After some discussion, the Board agreed to split up the minor **town responsibilities/departments** between board members, as follows: Transfer Station Stuart Huff/Animal Control, Cemeteries & Signs Rick Basford/Roads & Plowing Brent Chase. It was agreed to post on the door, on the website and to inform department employees.
- 5. Road Commissioner, Kyle King, spoke to the Board about getting a quote for Budget Meeting to pave the town's end of the **Basford Road**, since Detroit is planning on paving their end of that road in the upcoming year.
