**SELECTMENS' MEETING**

April 8, 2019

**7:00 PM - PRESENT:** G. Robison, W. Mitchell and 6 others

**MINUTES** of the March 25, 2019 Select Board Meeting were accepted on motion made by G. Robison. W. Mitchell seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**WARRANT #9** was accepted on motion made by G. Robison. W. Mitchell seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**APPOINTMENTS:** **Tim Parker** from Waldo County Lawn and Order, along with **Franz Spiegel**, discussed mowing options at the **town cemeteries**. It was agreed that the mowing would be handled by Franz Spiegel this mowing season, with the understanding that Tim Parker would submit another quote for next year and that the topic would be up for discussion again by the end of the year.

**OLD BUSINESS:** **W. Mitchell** discussed meeting with Charlie King at the **Sand & Salt Shed** to look at some issues that will need addressing, including the need for a 4 foot fan, a new emergency light, wall receptacles, resealing the cement and the removal of trees around the building. W. Mitchell will talk to Kevin at Wiswell Electric in Clinton regarding adding electricity to the road commissioner's shed.

**NEW BUSINESS:** **Tax Collector/Clerk Collections for March** were reviewed and initialed.

- G. Robison made a motion to appoint **James White** as an Appeals Board Member. W. Mitchell seconded. Vote was unanimous.
- The **Spring Clean-Up/Free Dump Day** was set for May 18, 2019.
- A **Homestead Exemption Application** was reviewed for Stephen Jaskela on the Mount Road.
- Roger Chadwick spoke with the Board regarding complaints of full bins at the **transfer station** during operating hours. It was agreed to contact Bolsters for Mike or Matt's phone number for David Chase to use when bins are too full when the Transfer Station is open. There was also some discussion of updates that could be made at the transfer station to make it safer and more efficient.

**ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIALS:** G. Robison made a motion to go into **EXEC. SESSION** to discuss three Concealed Weapons Permit Re-Applications and an ongoing Junkyard Issue at 197 South Horseback Road. W. Mitchell seconded. Vote was unanimous.
