**7:00 PM - PRESENT:** G. Robison, K. Hapworth and 1 other

**MINUTES** of the April 22, 2019 Select Board meeting were excepted on motion made by G. Robison. K. Hapworth seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**WARRANT #11** was accepted on motion made by K. Hapworth. G. Robison seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**APPOINTMENTS:**

**OLD BUSINESS:** The Board discussed possibly hiring a second attendant next year at the **Transfer Station**, as well as making a notice that Dump stickers must be visible on resident's windshields when entering the Transfer Station. Also, reviewed was a notice to Burnham residents regarding recycling in town, drafted by Kristy Hapworth. It was agreed to have the notice posted on the towns' website, along with the brochure from Unity Area Regional Recycling Center.

- A **Transfer Tax form** was signed for Pamela Sigston, which had briefly become Tax Acquired Property in December of 2018.
- The Board was informed that another quote was being obtained for the **Town Office and Veterans Memorial signs** from Swett Signs in South Paris.

**NEW BUSINESS:** G. Robison made a motion to appoint Randy Dondero as a **Democratic Ballot Clerk**. K. Hapworth seconded. Vote was unanimous.

- A partial April **Tax Collector/Clerk Collections** transfer to Arlene was reviewed.
- A **supplemental bill and tax certificate and warrant**, for Tree Growth Removal penalties for Joshua and Christy Whitcomb, were reviewed and signed.
- **Holding Tank applications** were signed for Clayton Sims and Leta Young, as per Randy Hall's instruction.
- Regarding the **polling hours** for the **school budget vote** on June 11, 2019, the Board decided on 8-6 pm.
