APPOINTMENTS: Bruce Cook spoke to the Board about the **Unity Ambulance** changing from a volunteer service to a paid service and the need for support from Burnham and six other neighboring towns in the immediate future. Also discussed was the need for a volunteer from town to attend upcoming monthly meetings with other towns and Unity Ambulance, to discuss the process of obtaining funding from the towns.

Mike and Matt Bolster discussed with the Board the Maine DEP inspection report from August 2024 and the need for a certain number of signs at the **Transfer Station** to designate areas and to state what items are not accepted. The topic of recycling again in town was also discussed.
