Select Board Minutes for Monday, July 7, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

Motion made by (BC) seconded by (RB) to accept the June 23, 2025, select board minutes; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (RB) seconded by (BC) to pay Warrant # 28 Payroll; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (BC) seconded by (RB) to pay Warrant # 29; vote was unanimous.

Per all the research by the Town of Burnham and the Town attorney, a motion was made by (RB) seconded by (BC) to accept a Memorandum: Status of Parsons Lane, received by the Town attorney, stating Parsons Lane is not a Town way and the Town has no obligation to maintain it. The road commissioner will remove the posts and road closure signs as soon as possible, and letters, with a copy of the Memorandum, are to be sent to the three landowners; vote was unanimous.

Motion made by (RB) seconded by (BC) to accept the Apollo Properties, LLC quote to make repairs to the Sand & Salt shed, minus the plywood for the back wall; vote was unanimous.

Per the special Town meeting held on June 23, 2025, the Townspeople voted to raise and appropriate the funds to pay the remaining balance at the Humane Society Waterville for the animal seizure case. (RB) made a motion to approve Warrant #27 in the amount of \$25,603.75 on June 24, 2025, and signed the warrant. (BC) came in later and seconded the motion and signed Warrant #27 so the check could be cut and mailed immediately, as to not lose the 25% discount the Humane Society Waterville offered the Town.

The selectboard reviewed MSAD #53 2025-2026 School Appropriations amounts; no action was taken.

The selectboard discussed a complaint a resident had about an animal seizure case; no action was taken.
